FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners of St John the Baptist!

This weekend we begin the season of Advent, a time of spiritual preparation for the celebration of Jesus' birth at Christmas. It is a season marked by prayer, penance and fasting.

Perhaps these coming weeks you can take some extra time to stop into church to spend some quiet minutes in prayer. We should come frequently to show Him our love. Gaze upon the crucifix. Meditate upon the saints depicted in the statues and the paintings. Imagine their life and how they served the Lord. Imagine how they prepared for Christmas. What joys filled their souls as they anticipated Christmas in the century they lived. They too adored Jesus in the Eucharist. The Eucharist spoke to their hearts and drew them into profound love for God and neighbor. This happened in adoration, but also most profoundly in the Sacrifice of Mass.

The Holy Mass is the greatest event in this world. It is not merely the recollection of past events but the proclamation of the mighty works wrought by God for men. (CCC 1363) These events are made present to the memory of believers so that we may conform our lives to them. In and through the Holy Mass, God conforms us to himself. At Holy Mass God acts upon us. We are changed by simply being in the presence of God at Holy Mass.

As we prepare for Christmas we want to draw others into this same love of our Lord in the Eucharist, his Holy presence among us today! One of the ways we can do this is through penance and the holy offerings of our comforts. These spiritual sacrifices tear down the powers of Satan and open the hearts of the souls made indifferent by the world.

We instinctively understand that prayer is effective. However, what about fasting? Jesus speaks frequently about fasting and its efficacy in the Gospels. Fasting helps us make more room for God in our life. Hunger and other passions are necessary for self-preservation. However, our desire for things such as food can block our deeper need for God. Our impulsivity leads to distraction and keeps us from prayer. Think of this the next time you grab your favorite sweet or salty treat. Why did you choose to satisfy a craving and not instead say a prayer? Fasting frees us to focus on the higher things of God.

As we prepare for Christmas consider a sacrifice you can make for the Lord and please encourage your family and friends to attend Holy Mass every Sunday. Untold graces are present at each and every Holy Mass.

May St. John the Baptist pray for us.

It has been now a few weeks since Fr. Mlsna was asked to take on the responsibility of Parochial Administrator at St. Patrick's in Mauston. With his absence, I reluctantly had to make several weekday Mass time changes. The Masses on Monday through Thursday will begin at 6:45am. This will allow me time to login to my Canon Law classes which begin at 7:30pm. Confessions will be available Monday through Thursday beginning at 6:15am until just before Mass begins. Confessions are also available after the 8:00am Saturday Mass and on the third Friday of the month beginning at 6:00pm.

Because my classes in January will be on Mondays and Wednesdays, Fridays seem to be the best option for my day off going forward. This will allow those who wish to attend Mass every day the continued option of doing so by attending Sacred Heart at 8am or one of the other local parishes in our Deanery. We will continue to offer First Friday Mass here at St. John the Baptist; however, Mass will be cancelled on the other Fridays. On Fridays St. John the Baptist will be opened at 6am as usual for anyone who would like to spend time in prayer before work. If you have a Mass intention scheduled for a Friday, it will be said in a private Mass by me unless you call the parish office and request a change. Would you like to offer prayers for someone special?

This year we have 20 students from St. John's parish preparing for Confirmation. In these times, our young people need our prayers. YOUTH GROUP IN ACTION!



Recently our Youth Group met to have a bit of fun and spread some cheer! The theme was **"Showing Gratitude"** as they got ready to celebrate Thanksgiving! They created gift baskets for people who might need encouragement or to know they are appreciated. The recipients of the baskets included youth, teachers, adults...anyone God placed on their hearts that might need a spiritual or emotional "lift"!

Who goes to Youth Group?

Youth group is open to young people in grades 8 - 12. We meet in the St. Francis Room of St. John the Baptist School. When you come, please enter through the St. Francis room door on the west side of St. John's Primary. St. Francis is above the door you will enter!

Why does Youth Group matter?

Youth group is meant to encourage and equip students in grade 8-12 to become joyful disciples of Jesus Christ. We do this by attending events, fellowship, prayer, music, service projects and more.

What happens at Youth Group?

- * We start with prayer.
- * We sing a praise song or two like "Good Good Father"
- * Everyone has a chance to share about their week, a high (positive thing) and low (negative thing).
- * We also ask if anyone has a "glory story" to share - something they did this week for God that they don't usually do.
- * We usually play a quick game.
- * I share about the theme for 15 to 20 minutes
- * We break into small groups or gather as one big group, discuss the theme and our thoughts about it.
- * We end with a snack and dismiss.

We will meet typically on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays with some exceptions.
